






Progress in women's access to leadership positions, in both political and economic spheres, remains sluggish

- Countries had in place an average of 76% of the laws and regulations needed to guarantee full and equal access to sexual and reproductive health and rights.






Violence against women and girls is prevalent across countries and affects women of all ages


