Excellency,

We would like to thank you for your continued engagement in the negotiations for the Ministerial Declaration of the high-level segment of the 2022 session of the Economic and Social Council and the high-level political forum on sustainable development, convened under the auspices of the Council.

Based on our discussions as well as your latest written proposals received, we are honored to share the fourth revised version of the draft of the Ministerial Declaration for your consideration. We trust that this draft can set the course towards the conclusion of this process.

A final informal meeting at expert level will be convened on Thursday, 30 June, in Conference Room 3 from 9 am to 1 pm and in the Trusteeship Council Chamber from 2 pm to 6 pm, to find consensual solutions to any unresolved issues that may remain. Once again, we encourage all delegations to reach out to other relevant parties to find compromise and consensual solutions to be presented by or during the next consultations.

After the informal meeting on 30 June, a final revised version will be placed under silence procedure.

We wish to appeal to all delegations for flexibility and a spirit of compromise as we work to finalize a declaration that can be adopted by consensus, sending a strong signal of commitment for the implementation of the 2030 Agenda by the international community at these challenging times.

We thank you for your collaboration and diligent efforts, and we look forward to the successful conclusion of this process, to ensure an outcome that produces a Ministerial Declaration that is ambitious, forward-looking, and consensual.
