# What % of 150'000 observations & recommendations of int. human rights monitoring bodies relates to SDG targets?

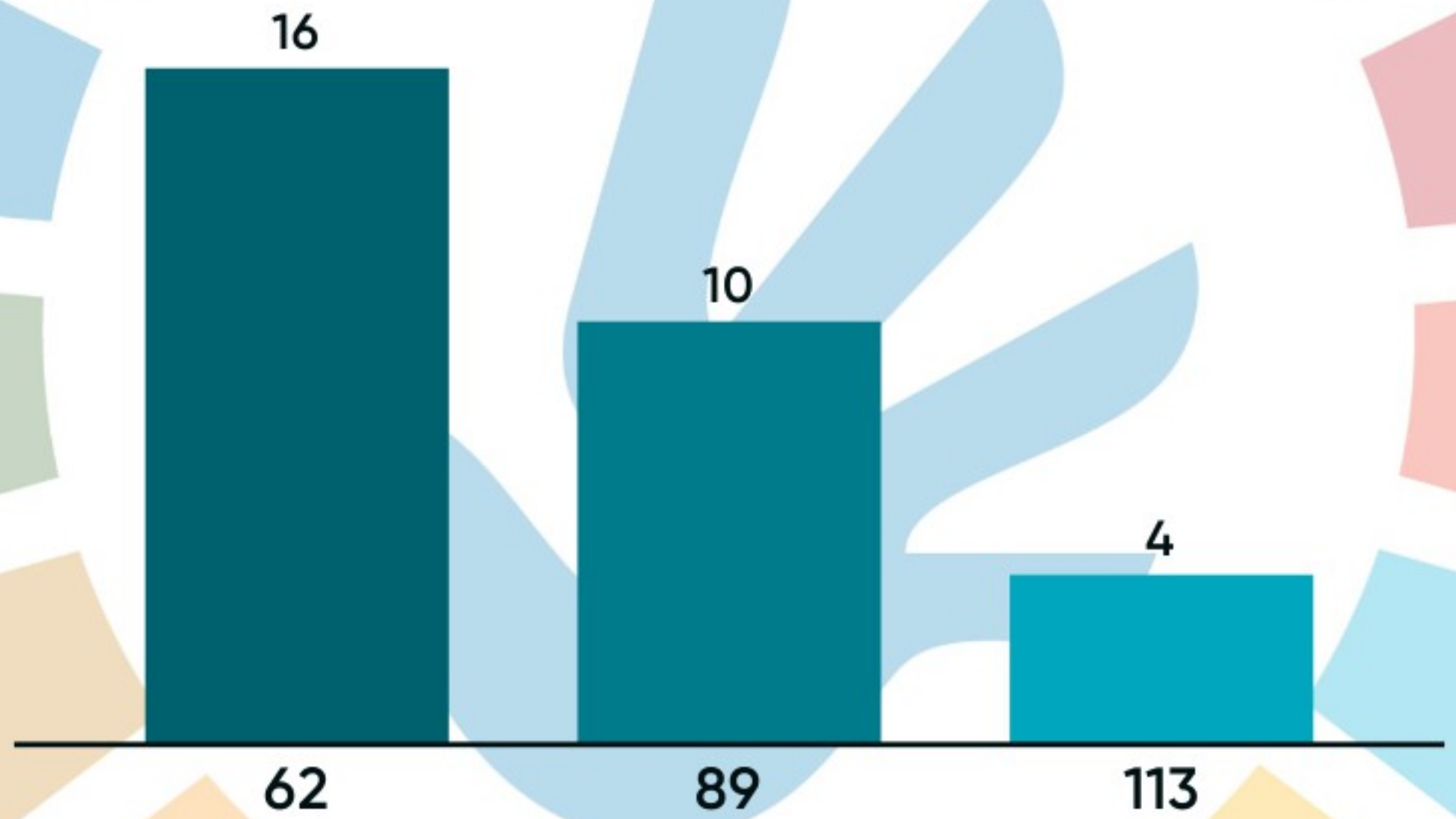


# Which of these 3 SDGs have most recommendations pertaining to indigenous peoples?
