The **sessions on the theme** will look at the theme through the lens of all 17 SDGs.

The **discussions on theme and SDGs** will be informed both by inputs from ECOSOC functional commissions and other intergovernmental bodies, a paper by MGoS, briefing notes prepared by the UN system and short background notes with questions for discussion, as well as presentations by panellists, to be followed by interactive discussions keeping in mind the principle of leaving no one behind and how SDGs are faring against it. A report of the Board of the 10YFP on SCP will also be considered with a view to give recommendations to the Board.

The session on interlinkages will address interlinkages among all six SDGs and among the rest of the SDGs including SDG 17.

The sessions on goal 17 will have as documentation agreed conclusions from the ECOSOC FFD forum and a summary of the STI Forum.

The sessions on individual SDGs will feature data on each of the SDGs as well as the state of implementation of each SDG.
