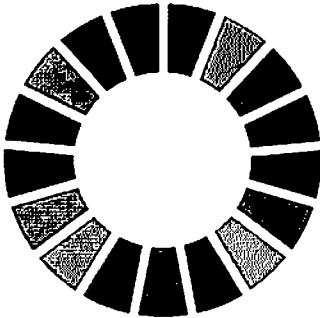

5 GENDER EQUALITY

Violence against women and child marriage are still prevalent in many countries

- While child marriage is slowly declining, still **1 in 4** women aged 20-24 were married before age 18 in 2015.
- 1 in 5** ever partnered women and girls (15 to 49 year old) have been subjected to physical and or/sexual abuse by an intimate partner, according to surveys taken between 2005 and 2016 in 87 countries.



5 GENDER EQUALITY

Women spend more time than men caring for family members and on domestic duties

- On average, women spent almost triple the amount of time on unpaid domestic and care work as men, based on data from 2010-2016 from 83 countries and areas.



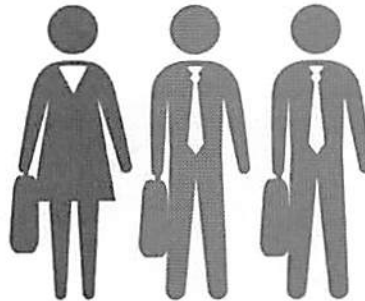
Gender	Median Value (h:m)

Men	7.0 (2 h 24 m)

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS



Women continue to be largely underrepresented in decision-making in public and private spheres

- Women's participation in single or lower houses of national parliaments worldwide reached only 23.4 per cent in 2017.
- In the majority of the 67 countries with data from 2009 to 2015, fewer than a third of senior- and middle-management positions were held by women.

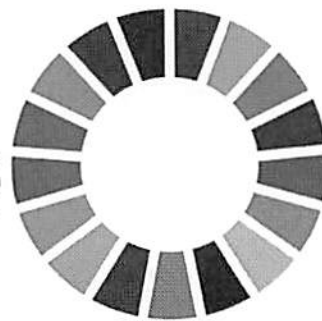
