By 2022, extreme poverty had returned to pre-pandemic levels in most countries, except low-income ones. In the 75 most vulnerable countries, 1 in 4 people lives on less than \$2.15 a day.




HALVED THEIR NATIONAL

^{*} Excluding Australia and New Zealand.


Working poverty has declined but still afflicts 241 million workers.

Central and Southern Asia notably reduced working poverty by 6.9 percentage points between 2015 and 2023.





1.4 billion, or 7 in 10 children worldwide lack social protection coverage.
