End poverty in all its forms everywhere

By 2022, extreme poverty had returned to pre-pandemic levels in most countries, **except low-income ones**. In the 75 most vulnerable countries, **1 in 4 people** lives on less than \$2.15 a day.

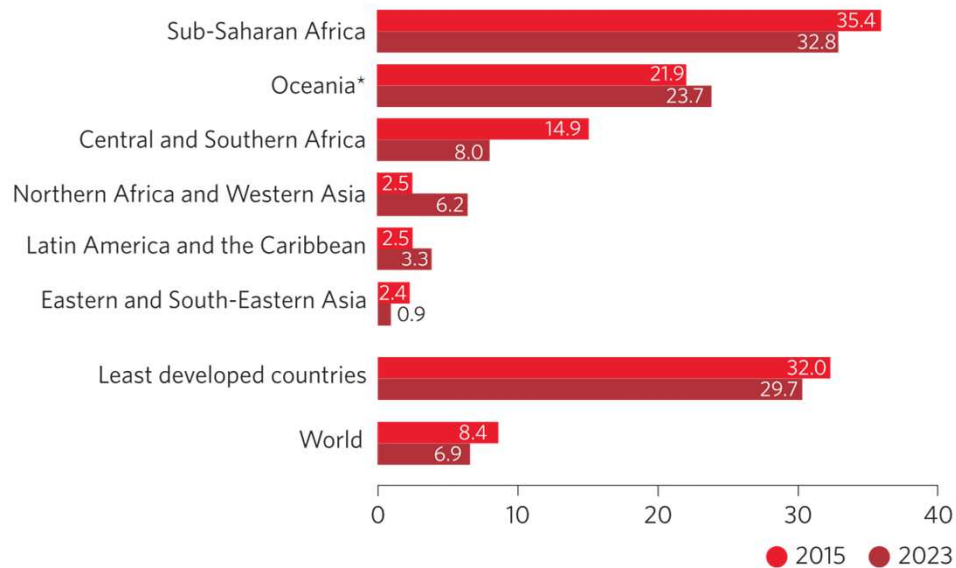

Working poverty has declined but still afflicts 241 million workers.

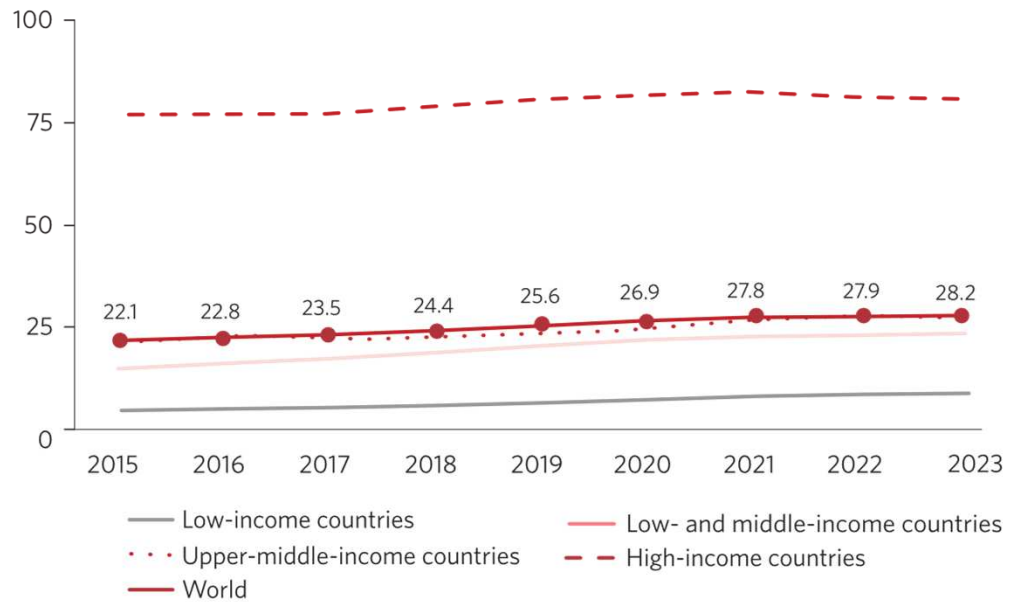
Central and Southern Asia notably reduced working poverty by 6.9 percentage points between 2015 and 2023.

1.4 billion, or 7 in 10 children worldwide lack social protection coverage.

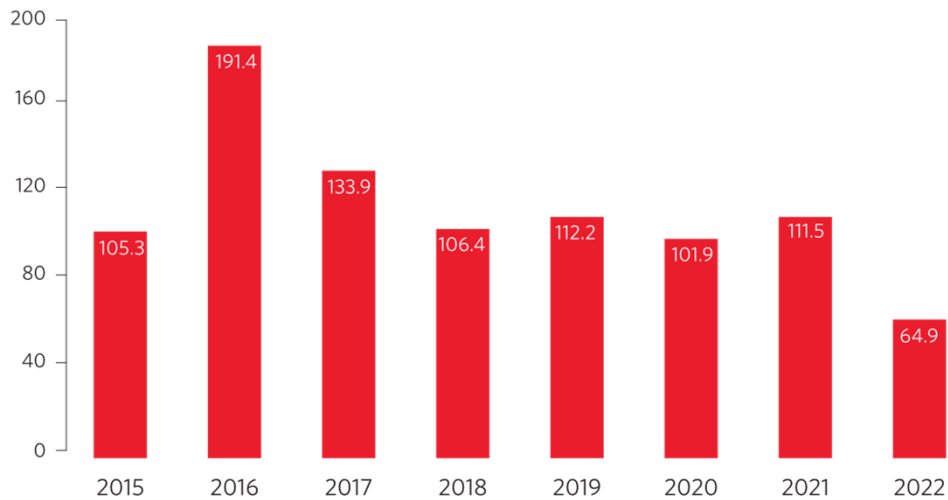
Proportion of children covered by social protection cash benefits, by country income level, 2015-2023 (percentage)

Direct economic losses from disasters, 2015-2022 (billions of dollars)



Disasters cause **\$115 billion** in **direct economic losses** annually.

Disaster-related economic losses in LDCs are over **6 times** the global average.
