

Main outcomes of Rio plus 20 on Green Economy:

1. A global commitment and common understanding of Green Economy in the context of sustainable development and poverty eradication. Clarity that this concept will contribute to the aim of sustainable development and that a transition is needed to an economy which acknowledges the finite resources of the planet and social and equity needs as committed to by the international community. This implies a renewed commitment to sustainable development and poverty eradication.
2. A **UN Green Economy Roadmap** which clarifies and stimulates the steps which are needed at the national and international level in order to remove the obstacles to get to a Green Economy. (...) The Roadmap should (...) **envisage tailor made advice by the UN system on national transformation policies to a green economy for all interested countries until 2020. Essential steps of implementation should be achieved until 2030.**
3. Catalogue, toolbox or best practice guide of actions, instruments and policies which can be implemented by Member States or individual organisations, taking into consideration the different framework conditions of developing countries, emerging economies and industrialized countries.
