

Chairperson of the Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice at its twenty-eighth session

Excellency,

I have the honour to write to you in my capacity as Chairperson of the twenty-eighth session of the Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice (CCPCJ) to offer additional substantive inputs of the Commission to the 2019 High-level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF).

Further to the submission made by the Commission on 11 March, the CCPCJ at its session in May 2019 under agenda item 10 had another opportunity to discuss its contribution towards the implementation of the 2030 Agenda on Sustainable Development in general, and of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and respective targets that are substantial to its mandate more particularly. The General Assembly in its resolution 73/183 had furthermore requested that inputs on how to further enhance this contribution be collected and made available to the Commission and the High-level Political Forum on Sustainable Development, as well as the 14th United Nations Congress on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice.

To this end, the parts of the 2019 report of the CCPCJ related to agenda item 10, as well as the information collected pursuant to General Assembly resolution 73/183, are made available as Annex I of the March submission, as requested. Additionally, the main messages of the voluntary national reviews relevant to the implementation of Sustainable Development Goal 16 are available on the Commission website as E/CN.15/2019/CRP.4.
