Subject: World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS) Forum substantive inputs to the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF) 2021

Sir,

I have the pleasure to submit the WSIS Forum inputs document to the thematic review of the HLPF 2021 that covers aspects of the response to the COVID-19 pandemic and the various actions and cooperation for achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

The annual <u>WSIS Forum</u>, co-organized by ITU, UNESCO, UNDP and UNCTAD, represents the world's largest annual gathering of the 'ICT for development multistakeholder community'. The Forum is a global multistakeholder platform facilitating the implementation of the WSIS Action Lines towards achieving the SDGs. The WSIS Forum builds upon the outcomes of the UN General Assembly Overall Review of the implementation of the WSIS outcomes (UNGA Resolution 70/125) that recognized the necessity of holding this Forum on an annual basis and called for a close alignment between the WSIS Process and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

In order to highlight the contribution of the WSIS Action Lines in accelerating the achievement of the SDGs, the ITU coordinated, with the UN Action Line Facilitators including, FAO, UNDESA, UNESCO, UNCTAD, UPU, ITU, WHO and WMO, a document entitled "WSIS Action Lines Contributing towards Accelerated action and transformative pathways: realizing the decade of action and delivery for sustainable development" that highlights the fifteen years implementation of the WSIS Action Lines.
