## Contributions of the Co-Chairs of the Ninth annual Multi-stakeholder Forum on Science, Technology and Innovation for the Sustainable Development Goals (STI Forum)

We wish to thank you for your letter dated 30 November 2023, in which you invited the Co-Chairs of the upcoming Multi-stakeholder Forum on Science, Technology and Innovation for the SDGs (STI Forum) to offer substantive inputs to the July session of the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF).

As co-chairs of the STI Forum, we are committed to ensuring that it provides relevant input to both the HLPF as well as the Summit of the Future in September.
