The Permanent Mission of Uruguay to the United Nations has the honor to present its compliments to the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development Secretariat - Department of Economic and Social Affairs of the United Nations and to refer to the note from His Excellency Mr. Lok Bahadur Thapa, President of ECOSOC, dated 31 July 2025, regarding the invitation to present the Voluntary National Report 2026 at the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF) in 2026.

In this context, the Permanent Mission wishes to express the interest of Uruguay in submitting its report, which is intended to include an in-depth review of the following Sustainable Development Goals: 6 (Clean Water and Sanitation), 7 (Affordable and Clean Energy), 9 (Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure), 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities), and 17 (Partnerships for the Goals).
